The Clean and Healthful Environment Clause of the Northern Mariana Islands Constitution grants the personal right that

Each person has the right to a clean and healthful public environment in all areas, including the land, air, and water. Harmful and unnecessary noise pollution, and the storage of nuclear or radioactive material and the dumping or storage of any type of nuclear waste within the surface or submerged lands and waters of the Northern Mariana Islands, are prohibited except as provided by law.<sup>2</sup>

While not an explicit EJ protection, it does include language that grants rights to a clean and healthful public environment in all areas.
